E-commerce, led by quick-commerce, accelerates FMCG growth in Q2

WAY FORWARD. Premium brands are growing twice as fast, digital platforms are fuelling premiumisation trends

E-commerce led by quick-commerce has emerged as the fastest growth channel for FMCG companies in Q2FY25.

Companies such as Parle Products, Nestle India, Adani Wilmar and Tata Consumer Products said they have been witnessing robust growth on the e-commerce channel.

At the same time, digital platforms are fuelling premiumisation trends in the country and premium brands in the FMCG sector are consistently growing nearly twice as fast as their non-premium counterparts, as per latest estimates released by NielsenIQ.

Krishnarao Buddha, Senior Category Head, Parle Products, told *businessline*, "In Q2 FY25, the FMCG industry witnessed strong

double-digit growth on the online channel which is primarily being driven by quick commerce platforms albeit on a small base. General trade channel has witnessed subdued growth and even modern trade is witnessing some bit of slow-down.

"This is because the dependability of consumers on quick commerce in the top cities is rising. For us, the online channel contributes about 4-5 per cent, of which nearly 1.5-2 per cent is now coming from quick commerce platforms."

In its Q2 FY25 investor presentation, Adani Wilmar said in Q2 revenue from "alternate" channels increased at a strong double-digit y-o-y, with revenue over the past 12 months exceeding ₹3,000 crore.

Earlier this week, Suresh Narayanan, Chairman & Managing Director, Nestle India, stated, "In Q2 FY25, e-

commerce channel grew by 38 per cent (which was the highest in the last seven quarters) for us... E-commerce channel's share was at 8.3 per cent of domestic sales, of which nearly 50 per cent contribution came from quick-commerce channels."

In an earnings call, Tata Consumer Products Ltd management also noted, "E-

commerce was 50 per cent growth. And in e-commerce, we saw quick commerce come in very, very strongly."

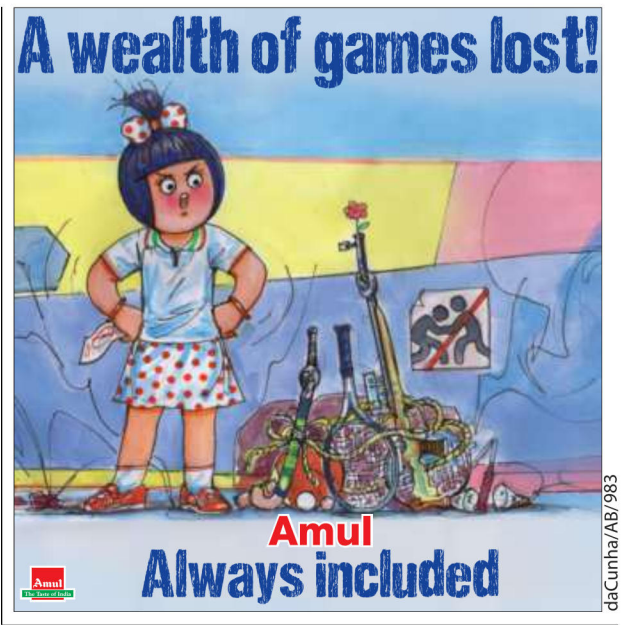
PREMIUM BRANDS Meanwhile, a report released by NielsenIQ noted premium brands in FMCG are consistently growing 2x as fast as their non-premium counterparts.

Nearly 50 per cent of e-commerce sales stem from the premium segment, it added.

Value contribution to FMCG sales of premium-products was pegged at about 27 per cent (MAT April '24) but this segment's contribution to total value growth of FMCG was higher at 42 per cent. Similar trends were also observed in the consumer durables space.

"We are observing an increasing convergence of aspirational consumer preferences with higher disposable incomes, as well as the presence and access to premium products.

"This shift is driven by digital platforms, contributing to nearly half of the sales. Market mix, channel diversity, and new entrants will further drive the adoption of premiumisation in the future," said Roosevelt Souza, Commercial Head - India, NielsenIQ.



BSNL gains subscribers in August on losses of Airtel, RJio, Vodafone-Idea

State-owned telecom operator Bharat Sanchar Nigam Ltd (BSNL) has benefited from recent tariff hikes by private telecom players, including Bharti Airtel (Airtel), Reliance Jio (RJio) and Vodafone-Idea (VIL), and added 2.5 million customers in August while the other three lost subscribers during the month.

This is the second consecutive month of subscriber growth for BSNL, the latest monthly data shared by the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) indicated on Friday. The data indicated that RJio lost the most number of subscribers in August by 4.01 million while Airtel lost 2.4 million and VIL 1.8 million subscribers. The three telcos increased their tariff plans in the range of 11 to 25 per cent in July.

NO TARIFF HIKE However, Robert Ravi, Chairman and Managing Director, BSNL, recently said, "There is no need of any tariff hike" in the near future.

Meanwhile, the TRAI subscriber data indicated that the number of total telephone subscribers in India decreased to 1,200.07 million at the end of August, thereby showing a monthly decline rate of 0.42 per cent compared with 1,205.17 million at the end of July. Total wireless subscribers decreased 1,163.83 million at



the end of August, thereby registering a monthly decline rate of 0.49 per cent, compared with 1,169.61 million in July.

URBAN VS RURAL "Wireless subscription in urban areas decreased from 635.46 million at the end of July to 633.21 million at the end of August, and wireless subscription in rural areas decreased from 534.15 million to 530.63 million during the same period. Monthly decline rate of urban and rural wireless subscription was 0.35 per cent and 0.66 per cent, respectively," TRAI said in its report.

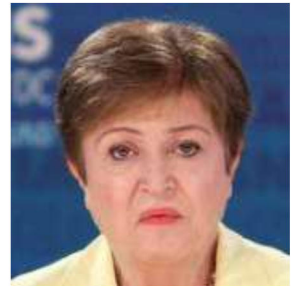
The regulator said that 14.66 million subscribers submitted their requests for mobile number portability in August. It further said Airtel has the highest number of machine-to-machine (M2M) cellular mobile connections of 28.41 million with a market share of 52.54 per cent as of August-end, followed by VIL, RJio and BSNL with market share of 27.18 per cent, 14.72 per cent and 5.56 per cent respectively.

World economy at risk of low-growth malaise: IMF

International Monetary Fund Managing Director Kristalina Georgieva warned on Thursday that the world is in danger of becoming mired in a low-growth, high-debt path that will leave governments with fewer resources to improve opportunities for people and tackle climate change and other challenges.

The result is increasingly dissatisfied populations, Georgieva said at a press

conference during the IMF and World Bank annual meetings in Washington. The meetings are clouded by the looming November 5

US presidential election, which raises the spectre that Americans, stung by high inflation during Democratic President Joe Biden's administration, could return Republican candidate Donald Trump to the White House, ushering in a new era of protectionist trade policies and trillions of dollars in new US debt.

WEAK DEMAND Dissatisfaction is not unique to the US, Georgieva said, despite the global economy showing some resilience in the face of threats from wars,

weak demand in China, and the lagged effects of tight monetary policy.

"For most of the world, a 'soft landing' is in sight, but people are not feeling good about their economic prospects," Georgieva said, referring to a scenario in which high inflation is tamed without a painful recession or large job losses. "Everybody I ask here, how is your economy? The answer is good. How is the mood of your people? The answer is not so good. Families are still hurting from high prices and global growth is anaemic."

The IMF on Tuesday released new economic forecasts showing that global GDP growth will decline slightly by 2029 to 3.1 per cent from 3.2 per cent this year, well below its 2000-19 average of 3.8 per cent, as current US strength fades.

At the same time, the IMF's Fiscal Monitor showed global government debt is set to top \$100 trillion for the first time this year and continue rising as political sentiment increasingly favours more government spending and is resistant to tax increases.

YouTube expands shopping in India with Flipkart, Myntra partnership

INDIAN CREATORS The programme adds to existing monetisation options like ad revenue, YouTube

premium, channel memberships and fan-driven features to help creators earn revenue.

Travis Katz, General Manager and Vice-President, Shopping, YouTube, said, "We're unlocking a new phase of product discovery, powered by the strong con-

nections between creators and their viewers.

"The YouTube Shopping affiliate programme offers Indian creators a unique opportunity to diversify their revenue streams and deepen their connection with their audiences. "We will look to gradually

expand to more partners in the future, as we continue to build our capabilities."

According to a Bain Report-How India Shops Online 2023, live commerce has grown rapidly in markets like South-East Asia and presents an opportunity in the Indian market.

Maldives discusses tourism sector prospects with India

India and Maldives are discussing tourism again starting with exploring the prospects for investment and development in the sector at an atoll south of the capital Male, a media report said on Friday.

The development comes days after Maldives President Mohamed Muizzu, during his first bilateral visit to New Delhi, termed India as "one of the largest tourism source markets" for his country and hoped that more Indian tourists would visit the archipelagic nation.

During his visit, India on October 7 asserted that its friendly ties with the Maldives will continue as Prime Minister Narendra Modi and President Muizzu unveiled a blueprint for comprehensive economic and maritime cooperation, signalling a reset of the relationship that hit a rough patch towards end 2023 and early 2024.

On Friday, the state-run PSM Media said Maldives' Minister of Tourism Ibrahim Faisal discussed tourism development opportunities in Baresdhoo and Gaadhoo in Laamu Atoll with the Indian High Commissioner to the Maldives Munu Mahawar on Thursday.

PRIORITY AREA In a post on X, Faisal said it was a "productive visit" to Laamu Atoll with Mahawar,

where the two explored "exciting prospects for tourism investment and development."

Faisal, Mahawar and other officials from both sides visited Baresdhoo and Gaadhoo as part of the tour in Laamu Atoll.


"Discussed its potential as a key site for tourism development and how we can unlock new opportunities for growth, while preserving the island's natural beauty and heritage," Faisal added in the post.

Responding to his post, Mahawar said on X, "Tourism sector is a priority area of our bilateral cooperation and we look forward to working closely with the Government of Maldives to further enhance this partnership." Tourism is the main source of economic activity for the Maldives, contributing nearly 30 per cent of the GDP and generating more than 60 per cent of foreign exchange.

TRADE RELATIONS The High Commissioner's tour comes at a time when both countries are working to strengthen trade relations, the PSM Media said.

Muizzu's recent state visit to India resulted in the signing of five agreements to enhance bilateral cooperation.

Muizzu won the presidential election last year on the 'India out' campaign and within 24 hours of swearing-in, asked New Delhi to withdraw its military personnel posted in his country.
